Alden Food Pantry Acquisition

Purpose: To raise funds to purchase the building and property that house the Alden Food Pantry and set up a seed fund for future expenses related to the building. The City of Alden has agreed to take over ownership and maintenance of the building following the purchase.

Goal: \$70,000

To make a donation: Checks should be made out to ADC/Horizons, with the notation Alden Food Pantry on the memo line. The Alden Development Corporation is the 501(c)3 organization which has set up an account for the purpose of acquiring the food pantry, and Horizons is the subgroup of the ADC which will facilitate the transfer.

Donations may be mailed or taken directly to the United Bank and Trust, P O Box 68, 914 Main St. Alden, Iowa 50006, placed in the offering at any of the three churches in Alden, or given directly to a member of the Acquisition Team.

Food Pantry eligibility and usage: Approximately 75-100 people per month are utilizing the food pantry. Of those, approximately 35 are children. Anyone who is in need of food assistance is eligible to come to the food pantry. Current hours of operation are 4 - 6 pm on Friday and 9 - 11 am on Saturday.

Shawn Loughren of UBT is an advisory member of the team.
