





The pantry will stay in its current location allowing for a continuation of service to the clients. Pat and Betty made many improvements during the time they owned the building. These improvements included the following new items: roofing, furnace, air conditioning, cement driveway, lighting, flooring in 1/2, windows and shelves. The plumbing was also wrapped. The new windows have helped by reducing the electric bill by \$50 to \$70 a month. As life situations have changed, they have moved to Ames. Pat and Betty plan to continue to help support Alden with donations to benefits such as Alden days, volunteering at the pantry, etc.
