



FROM SPANISH EXPLORERS AND FRENCH TRAPPERS, TRADERS AND PRIESTS; TO THE DOMINANT ENGLISH, GERMANS AND IRISH; TO SCANDINAVIANS, DUTCH AND CZECHS, WE'LL EXPLORE WHY THESE GROUP CHOSE TO LEAVE THEIR HOMELANDS AND HOW THEY EVENTUALLY ENDED UP IN IOWA. 


