There were four brothers  
came to Massachusetts  
of the Kemp family  
probably before 1640.

William Kemp came  
in the ship "James",  
April 5, 1635, settled in  
Duxbury, Mass., where  
he became a proprietor  
and jury man, admitted  
freeman March 5,  
1638-39; grant of land  
Jan. 7, 1638-39.

Robert Kemp settled in  
Dedham, Mass., was  
admitted to the church  
April 24, 1639.

(1) (Edward Kemp) the other  
relative settled in Dedham

and was probably brother  
of of Robert. He was a  
proprietor, and Oct. 28,  
1638 was admitted free-  
man March 13, 1638-39  
he removed to New-  
hamp, Mass., and de-  
clined the office of deacon  
in 1651. Removed to  
Chelmsford 1655,

Samuel.

2. (Samuel Kemp) married  
Sarah, daughter of Sergt,  
Thomas Foster of Brai-  
tree, May 23, 1662,

3. (Zerubbabel) son of Samuel was born about 1666. He settled in Groton. He and his wife, Mary were baptized and admitted to the covenant and had two children baptized, at Groton May 15 1709, children Ebenezer Zerubbabel, John, Mary, Dorothy, Heseekiah and Sarah,

4. (John Kemp) son of Zerubbabel was born in Groton, Jan 18, 1707, and died there, children, John, Lawrence, Oliver, Gabez, Stephen, Lucy, Amasa and Sarah,

5. (Capt Lawrence Kemp) son of John Kemp, born Sept 24, 1733 and died at Groton Oct. 2, 1805. He was a soldier

in the French and Indian War, Capt. Clessow Company of Deerfield, was Capt. in the 13th Company Col. David Field's Regiment, commissioned May 3, 1776 and was at Ficonderoga in 1777, was Capt. in Col. David Wells' Regiment in Burgoyne's campaign.

He removed from Groton to Deerfield and thence in 1787 to Shelburne, Mass.
